Teams of volunteers will speak with every person they meet as they walk through a specified area to determine if they are homeless. Surveys will be conducted anonymously and respectfully across the city. Volunteers are required to attend one hour of training prior to the evening of the assessment. Adults interested in committing to a meaningful volunteer experience are encouraged to participate.
