Note: These data are coded according to the 1995 list of 53 provinces. This is an increase from the 40 provinces reported in the 1989 Census. Note that the provinces of Hanoi, Hai Phong and Ho Chi Minh include outlying rural areas. By 1996, there was a reclassification of provinces which led to splits of eight provinces into 16 new provinces: Bac Thai is split into Bac Can and Thai Nguyen; Ha Bac is split into Bac Giang and Bac Ninh; Hai Hung is split into Hai Duong and Hung Yen; Minh Hai is split into Bac Lieu and Ca Mau; Nam Ha is split into Ha Nam and Nam Dinh; Quang Nam-Da Nang is split into Da Nang City and Quang Nam province; Song Be is split into Binh Duong and Binh Phuoc; and Vinh Phu is split into Vinh Phuc and Phu Tho provinces. To avoid confusion, we retain the list of provinces as it was in 1995.
