

Postdoctoral Scholar (Marteleteo)– University of Texas at Austin

Description:

The Population Research Center (PRC) at the University of Texas at Austin seeks 1-2 full-time postdoctoral scholars to work on inequalities on reproductive health and fertility within the NICHD-funded DeCodE project. The PRC is an interdisciplinary research and training unit of The University of Texas at Austin (UT) that provides infrastructure support services and project development support for a very productive, interdisciplinary group of faculty, postdocs, graduate students, and undergraduate students. This position will be appointed in the PRC to work on the DeCodE project led by Principal Investigator Letícia Marteleteo. The post-doctoral associate will have the opportunity to join and integrate existing datasets on socio-demographic and economic factors, reproductive health and fertility in Brazil collected before and during the pandemic as well as administrative data to more completely assess the effects of public health crises on fertility and reproductive health. The postdoctoral scholar will be expected to engage in advanced research within the area and participate fully in the research life of the research group and the PRC.

The expected start date of this position is set for August 02, 2021. The initial term of appointment is one year, but reappointment for a second year is expected following successful review. **Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis beginning March 10, 2021.**

Eligibility:

- Applicants must have completed all doctoral degree requirements by the time of entry into the program.
- Applicants must be able to provide documentation/proof of work authorization in the U.S.

Salary:

- \$51,000+, depending on qualifications and experience

4. List of 3 References Required. One reference should be your dissertation chair.
