Lab 1: Creating Your Account and a Project

Purpose

In this lab, you will learn how to create an account and create a project. The path you take will depend on whether or not you already have a UW NET ID. Start below if you have a UW NET Id. Otherwise, if you do not have a UW NET ID, skip ahead to page 4.

Part 1 - Option 1: You have a UW NET ID

 Navigate to <u>https://surveys.csde.washington.edu/</u> If you are not already signed in with your UW NetID, you will first be asked to do this. Then you should see the form below.




