Narrative

Funding from CSDE would support the development of the first comprehensive affordable housing text that is relevant for both teaching and community partners. The purpose of the book is to provide readers with a thorough review of the multiple domains and forces that interact to constitute the field of affordable housing. The book will provide undergraduate and graduate students, and the professional community, with a comprehensive summary of affordable housing and the systems, policies, and forces that interact to determine the affordability of housing in the U.S. There are few books that focus exclusively on affordable housing. Those that do concentrate on a very specific aspect such as the development or financing of affordable housing. There is currently no resource on the market that provides a comprehensive summary of the concept of affordable housing in the United States, a gap we seek to fill with this project. We are under contract with Routledge on the book and the first draft is due this summer. This book serves as the foundation of our broader research agenda that analyzes the provision (or lack thereof) of affordable housing in the U.S.
